Seedball Making Activity

This activity is the most common practice since ages to contribute to the state of the environment. Tree plantation would address two major concerns - Climate Change and Reducing Green Cover.





A seed ball (or seed bomb) is a seed that has been wrapped in soil materials, usually a mixture of clay and compost and then dried. Essentially, the seed is 'pre-planted' and can be sown by depositing the seed ball anywhere suitable for the species, keeping the seed safely until the proper germination window arises. Seed balls are an easy and sustainable way to cultivate plants in a way that provides a larger window of time when the sowing can occur.

What Do We Do?

We at Vidyaranya have been able to conduct several seedball and other environment activities like high density plantation, lake rejuvenation, lake clean-ups, etc with clients like AT&T, Citrix, Concentrix etc.

We urge more volunteers to come forward and help heal our planet earth.

Government School Refurbishment





Vidyaranya visited a Government School in Bangalore rural district and post-assessment found that the school lacks proper infrastructure which is hindering the delivery of quality education and overall growth of the children. With the support of Molex we refurbished the school.



The following processes were overlooked by us:

- Demolition process
- Basic construction
- Chipping & painting
- Waterproofing

Apart from the above renovation processes we also provided the school with chairs, projector, tables, etc.

By refurbishing the school we came closer to our goal of providing proper infrastructure for unobstructed education.

This also further reduces the attrition rate of the children at school as quality education is given.

The community's negative perception about education is changed and thereby, the enrollment of more children.
